
Materials

» Template

» Coloured pencils, charcoal and/or highlighters

- » Black markers
- » Glue
- » Scissors (parental supervision advised!)







Step 1

Copy or print the provided template (click here to download).

Step 2



Cut out the sunflower, draw and colour to create designs.

Step 3

Use permanent markers to outline and draw patterns on the petals.





Step 4

Cut out the petals, fold at the bottom of each petal, glue the petals onto the back of the sunflower, and then crease the centre line on the petals to create a 3D effect.
