





Over 150 years ago, 13 brave Aboriginal men in Western Victoria picked up their cricket bats and embarked on a treacherous voyage to England and into the unknown – all in the name of sport.

Risking illness and persecution, Australia's first international cricket team – including Australia's first Indigenous sporting hero, Johnny Mullagh – amazed the English crowds with astonishing talent, personality and grit. They should have returned to Australia as celebrated heroes. Instead they came back to find the world they once knew was no longer there.

This is not just a story about cricket – this is story of strength, resilience, hope and possibility. When a group of young present-day activists sneak into the Wimmera Discovery Centre to expose the truth of what happened to Johnny and his team mates, a hidden legend of triumph and tragedy unfolds. 

The 2022 Regional Children's Chorus program will give 24 children aged between 9 and 14 years in the Port Macquarie-Hastings region the chance to perform as the Chorus in Opera Australia's touring regional production, *The Barber of Seville*.

Children will audition and then train with local Chorus Master, Victoria Stanmore. Victoria has trained in Piteå, Sweden at a Masters level with Erik Westberg and Petter Sundkvist, with an emphasis on chamber choir leadership. She is a member of the NSW board of the Australian National Choral Association.

On the day of the performance, children rehearse onstage with the professional cast and orchestra, then perform in costume that night. Side by side with some of Opera Australia's finest singers, the Children's Chorus will feel the magic of live theatre performance.

Through the rehearsal and performance process, children also gain a wider understanding of opera, which we hope sparks interest in future artistic pursuits.
